Robert Linzeler was a Parisian Jeweller and silversmith who, amongst other works created many important sailing trophies in the early 20th century

Stylistically, this tureen owes its design to the masterworks of Pierre Germain from the mid 18th century & is an excellent example of the Rococo style.

It is a testament to his extraordinary workmanship and attention to detail that he succeeded Jules Pialt, silversmith to Napoleon III, before forming a partnership with another French silversmith, Alexander Marchak, in 1922.
